

## What happens when we come before the enthroned Image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus?

- ♥ When family members spend a night hour of reparation praying before the Image (at least once a month) they experience a new depth of love, self giving, and awareness of God's Indwelling Presence in their souls.
- ♥ The hour of prayer before the Image of the King of Love (made between 9 pm and 6 am) becomes an act of reparation for the sins of the world which are so frequently committed during the night hours.
- ♥ As we view His Image we think of His living beating Heart present in the Eucharist and we adore Him in Spirit in all the tabernacles throughout the world.
- ♥ These hours of reparation begin to change our hearts; as we become more loving— others are drawn towards Jesus, vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life are fostered, and the Social Reign of the Sacred Heart begins to spread outward from our family.

How does the Sacred Heart of Jesus reveal God's Love for us?

We are created by Love to enjoy the Communion of Love between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit forever.

Although sin separates us from this Love, the Father sends His Son into the world enthroning Him as King and anointing Him with His Spirit, "Thy throne, O God, is forever and ever. . . God, thy God, has anointed thee with the oil of gladness..." (Heb 1:8, 9)

The Holy Spirit overshadows Mary and the Sacred Heart of Jesus is conceived and enters the Holy Family.

With Jesus as their center Joseph and Mary enter ever more deeply into the self giving Love in Whose Image they are created, and they guide us on our own journey out of sin and back into the Heart of God.

Jesus lived and died for us and His Sacred Heart was pierced on the Cross to open for us the fountain of Baptism and the Holy Eucharist.

At Holy Mass we enter into the Heart of Jesus offered as the perfect sacrifice to the Father through the Holy Spirit.

We receive the Heart of Jesus into our own bodies at Holy Communion, and in His Heart all the other members of His Mystical Body joined to Him through Baptism.

Jesus remains physically present in all the consecrated hosts throughout the world and He invites us to spend time adoring His Eucharistic Presence and deepening our friendship with Him.

"Adoration outside Holy Mass prolongs and intensifies what has taken place in the liturgical celebration" (Benedict XVI; 6-10-07).

"Indeed, in the Eucharist, worship must become union: union with the living Lord and then with his Mystical Body" (Benedict XVI; 3-13-09).

Jesus is in love with us and desires to be invited into our families through the Enthronement of an Image of His Sacred Heart.

When we enthrone Jesus as King we are entering into an action of the Father and we receive a deeper anointing of the Holy Spirit.
